

GOVERNOR'S PARK TENNIS CENTER

Daniel Island, South Carolina

SeamonWhiteside + Associates provided complete project master planning, landscape architecture, and civil engineering services for this 35-acre state-of-the-art tennis tournament facility on Daniel Island.



The complex, which is managed by the Family Circle Women's Tennis Cup and owned by the City of Charleston, includes 13 clay tennis courts (including the main stadium court), four hard courts, a 10,200 square foot clubhouse, a grand lawn for corporate events, and other entertainment opportunities, walking/biking trails, a hospitality grove, pedestrian boardwalk and brick plazas. The facility will be incorporated into the neo-traditional neighborhood's Town Center area and was designed for mostly pedestrian access.



Situated along the Wando River, the complex will also take advantage of scenic views and will feature a floating dock to allow for tournament visitors to arrive by water taxi.

The Tennis Center at Daniel Island was awarded an Outstanding Facilities Award by the United States Tennis Association (USTA) and was named "the finest public tennis facility in America" by Tennis Industry magazine in their Fall 2001 issue.
