

STALL HIGH SCHOOL

SeamonWhiteside + Associates contracted to provide civil engineering and landscape architectural services as part of a design team for the new Stall High School in North Charleston, SC. The new 1,500-student school is with three classroom wings containing a cafeteria, gymnasium, media center, and multi-purpose room in addition to the classroom space. Athletic fields for baseball, softball, soccer, football, and track and field events needed to be



included in the design, which due to the smaller than average site for a high school (54-acres) presented the design team with a significant challenge. Careful placement and engineering of the fields, access roads, and parking areas has resulted in the new high school having all of the desired facilities.

Although there are currently no plans to seek certification, LEED guidelines were employed during the design of the new facility. The new Stall High School is scheduled to open to students for the 2010-2011 school year.
