

MAULDIN SPORTS CENTER

Mauldin, South Carolina



As with many small towns today, the City of Mauldin has recently targeted downtown revitalization as a community goal. The new 36,000 sq. ft. sports and recreation building is located on the site of the old Mauldin Elementary School and is part of the future Mauldin Cultural Center. The facility is designed to be built in two phases.

The first phase was completed in 2007 and is comprised of administrative offices, a gymnasium, fitness and weight rooms, an indoor walking track, locker rooms and a Sports Museum. SW+ A performed civil and landscape architectural design services for the project, which is at the center of Mauldin and adjacent to the new municipal city hall and police department building.

In addition to landscape architectural design services including landscape and irrigation planning, SeamonWhiteside + Associates completed design of an entry road with parking, on-site stormwater detention, permitting services, utilities, and construction observation for the new Sports Center.

Project architect DP3 Architects, Ltd. received a Silver Brick in Architecture award from the Brick Association of the Carolinas in 2007 for the first phase of the project.
